Unfortunately, there was no volunteer to do it either including the general secretary and the treasurer of the organization, who are then active Board members. As the President of the organization, I must express my disappointment that there was not willingness and desire to take any responsibilities on behalf of the organization on that capacity and any solid commitments. This MUST change in the New Term within the context of that each and every board member has to take a key and secondary responsibility – share responsibility with the president as well as among other members of the board, and should demonstrate an ongoing supportive manner of the organization. It is very obvious that showing up at the Meeting, it is the very first and crucial step yet that alone didn't/wouldn't bring in any support or empowerment of the organization based on previous term that was also the very case during the last meeting (May 26, 2010).

PROJECTS-PROPOSALS & Proposal for the UNNGO Conference to be held in Istanbul in 2012.

Re-sent my earlier and updated draft proposal for the UN-DPI/NGO Conference to be held in Istanbul, Turkey, which goes back to 2008 then also last year that I sent it to the Permanent Mission of Turkey to be held in Istanbul, Turkey in 2012 or 2013; resent it on

June 17, 2011, which was also sent in to Madam Marta Santos Pais, *Special Representative* of the UN Secretary-General on Violence against Children; among Turkish Mission and representatives of the Department of Public Information on December 19, 2011. The recent motion has started on this issue based on my attendance to the UN-DPINGO Executive Board Meeting on Friday, June 3,2011, in which, I've also proposed this idea to the current DPINGO Executive Committee.

Ataturk: Through the Lenses of the Millennium Development Goals

Initial proposal was submitted to the Permanent Mission of Turkey to the United Nations among Turkish Consulate of NY, Turkish Federation and many other Turkish-American organizations on January 11, 2011, which was targeted for May 19, 2011, that was not realized (for the initial proposal:

Recently, I've revised the initial project and linked it with the International Peace Day that is also work in progress, and will be re-submitted during the first week of July to the Turkish Mission among 2-3 other Missions with a new targeted date, which is preferably for: September 15. Emily L. Joyce has indicated that she will help me for its further development process and editing.

A Developing idea as an essay or open letter or initiative: "A UN STATE for the 12 MILLION STATELESS IN THE WORLD!"

Inspired this idea from the UN-NGO Briefings, which was dedicated to "Refugees in Current Conflicts: 1 Resolution – Human Rights Protection" took place at the Salvation Army, NYC, on Thursday, 16 June, 2011.

Based on the panel discussion and given facts and references, I posed the following question during the Q&A Session's of the above *Briefing: Why cannot the UN form a UN State for the 12 Million of the Stateless People in the world?* My question was reposed by **Gail Bindley-Taylor Sainte**, *Information Officer of the Department of Public Information, and was moderator of the Briefing;* as "utopist" to the panelists. At the UN; any idea only could take into account/consideration if a two missions jointly work on it and start collecting signature from other member states for a Resolution on that particular idea. With that information, at the end of the Briefing, I expressed my thought to Gail that it is not an "utopist idea". Panelist from the UN-HR asked, "where?", and also suggested that UN-Political Affairs might be right entity to ask this question.

I've shared this idea with three ambassadors and two first secretaries in the same evening during the reception of the UN-Population Awards at the Delegates Dining Room of the UN. In particular, Ambassador of Taiwan has encouraged me greatly, and already gave a strong reference as well as willing to give further advise once I've sent him my Draft. And, he has emphasized that I see it as an emerging "initiative" that I was not aware of it when I asked the question or shared my thoughts with them. In summary, I have not written my Draft up to moment yet but my desire writing on it and search for further references continue. I will share it when it is ready. Ongoing process:

Knitting Non-Profits with the Millennium Development Goals

Emily L. Joyce re-wrote my initial proposal to QPTV among its cover letter; and we've jointly developed it further and finalized it. Sent in to Mark Willis, Chase Manhattan Foundation but he promptly responded that he is not with the Chase anymore. Also, I've submitted it to Councilman Lorey Comrie (Jamaica, Queens) on Wed. June 15, 2011. I thank to Emily L. Joyce for her patient and diligent work on this proposal and related cover letters.

UNDEF:

Our Proposal to the UN-Democracy Fund, which was submitted on December 31, 2011; we were not selected for the Short List. I've been told that the UNDEF has received near to

4000 applications and within those only 64 were selected for the Short-List. And, we've been encouraged by the UNDEF to apply for the next round in November 2011.


