8. The Evaluation Committee will run plagiarism and AI tools on each submission to determine whether the submission is original or not.
9. The Organization DOES NOT PUBLISH ANY ADVERTISEMENT/ COMMERCIALS. However, it may seek collaborators/sponsors/funders/donors for this particular project through its #501c3 tax-exempt status. Only those names and/or organizations/private or public entities will be reflected accordingly under the related sections of all related print and/or online outreach materials.
10. All Applicants should include his/her narrative bio of 100-130 words along with portrait photos (jpg or png format) along with the submission.
11. Each of the portrait photos of the applicant should be taken during the last 6 months of the application date.
12. Bio should contain the following information: first and last name, school name, city/country, age, grade (dropouts should be mentioned at which grade he/she had dropped it out), email, parent or guardian

email/contact information, along with study and/or interest areas and reason to apply.

13. Media and Digital Arts Category: Submitters are required to provide a complimentary statement of around 250-350 words on the submitted and non-English video projects must have English subtitles along with “Complimentary Text” should be in English.
14. Digital Arts/Media Category may be submitted as seven (7) pieces in “pdf”, or “jpg”, or “png” format with min. 200 to 300 resolution and a horizontal format is suggested.
15. Submitters aged 18 and over are themselves responsible for their submissions and do not require school and/or family confirmation. Regardless, each submitter is required to sign and submit the Consent Form, which should include a statement of agreement to the Publishing Policy of the Organization.

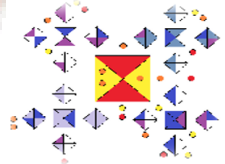
